Creating a Punchout Requisition charged to a Project (RSSP)




This guide walks through how to create a punchout requisition charged to a project (POETAF) in Oracle Financials - Procurement in the Redwood Self-Service Procurement (RSSP) style. Click the red play button to view a video of the process.



#### Steps to Take



1. Log into Oracle Financials through RSpace, and then navigate to the "Procure to Pay" tab.
2. Select the "Purchase Requisitions" tab.
3. Scroll down to the "Shop by Category" section and select one of the displayed punchout catalogs or click the "All Punchout Catalogs" for additional selections.
4. The supplier's webpage will display. Select the desired products, add them to the cart and then click the "Checkout" button. The webpage will redirect to Oracle Financials - Procurement (RSSP) to complete the order.



Note: Punchout catalog requisitions will show the supplier logo on the tile in the My Recent Requisitions section.
